The comic itself did not begin posting until 2012, when I finally worked out all the kinks in order to tell a functioning story with the complexity that this comic contains.

As far as comic art and writing go, I have completely learned throughout the process. It has been quite a journey; however, as anyone can imagine this results in a lot of really amateur work, especially in the first few chapters of the story. My goal is to one day have the comic printed in a beautiful hardcover book, and in order to do that I have to go back and fix most of the old pages. This is of course time consuming, but it is my dream and for as long as I am on this earth, I intend to work towards that dream.

So in the spirit of revival, I renamed the comic to “Serpents of the Old Nature”-- a title I believe is much more fitting to the story and one I am much more comfortable with. I have started rewriting the old chapters and for current fans there is no need to worry! All the major plot elements are the same! The only thing that is different are some of the character development scenes--- some are added, some are taken away, some are adjusted a bit to be more suitable for the characters. I think existing readers will appreciate the renovated storyline, and new readers will enjoy something that is structured properly right from the beginning!

Production has gotten too much for me to handle on my own and still maintain the quality I wish to keep, so I have hired an artist friend of mine to line my drawings and color in the flat colors on the characters. Then I come back in with the backgrounds, lighting, and shading. As you can imagine, costs add up--- especially when I can get to the point of revamping the older pages at a faster rate.
